





Staff who are regularly in close contact with students will be provided with all appropriate personal protective equipment. This equipment is especially important where there is the potential for contact with bodily fluids.

Staff who are required to wear PPE for protection against workplace hazards besides COVID-19 must continue to use that PPE as required. This includes gloves for new cleaning and disinfecting products that workers use because of COVID-19 and may include N95 masks.

Visitors (essential personnel) are required to wear a mask.

In the case where a student or staff becomes symptomatic at school/in the workplace, they will be required to quarantine in a designated space and use PPE (mask, gown and hand sanitizer) until they can safely leave the school/building.

May not be tolerated by everyone based on underlying health issues. Consideration should be given to mitigating any possible physical or psychological injuries that may inadvertently be caused by wearing a face covering (e.g. interfering with the ability to see or speak clearly).

Appropriate medical documentation will be required by students (Grades 1-12) and staff who have health issues that prevent them from wearing a mask while at school, and for K-12 students who are riding the bus.

Should be changed if visibly soiled, damp or damaged.

If worn or disposed of incorrectly, could lead to increased risk of infection.

Staff are responsible for the safe use and cleanliness of their own mask, as well as the proper use and disposal of masks.
