





Retesting is not recommended and will not alter the 14-day isolation requirement. Retesting should only be done if recommended by the TBDHU. Note that individuals do not need to provide a medical note or proof of negative test results to return to school.



Remote learning will include a combination of synchronous learning that happens in real time with the classroom teacher (and involves using text, video, or voice communication) that enables the educators and other members of the school to instruct and connect with students, and asynchronous learning that students will engage in independently at home (and includes the watching of video lessons, completing assigned tasks or contributing to online discussions).
